

ST LUCIA BIBLE CHURCH

WHAT IS A BIBLE CHURCH?

At St Lucia Bible Church, we believe God's Word, the Bible is our ultimate authority. God has revealed His plans and purposes for all mankind through His Word and so Bible teaching is the foundation of our church. We preach through various books of the Bible, chapter by chapter, so that God sets the agenda and we hear the Bible taught in context. The Bible gives an accurate picture of the world, ourselves and our need for a Saviour, Jesus Christ. As the Bible is taught, God graciously saves and transforms lives.

OUR HISTORY

SLBC started in February 1996 as Unichurch. Christian students at UQ, who had come from a variety of churches from around the state, were looking for a Bible teaching church to attend together. Starting as an evening congregation, a year later a family friendly morning service was added. The name of our morning gathering changed in late 2012 to St Lucia Bible Church, to clarify that we aren't a Uniting Church or only for University students. It also clarified the style of church we are - a Bible teaching church.



OUR GATHERINGS

We are one church 'organisationally' - we pray for each other, hear the same sermons, share the same staff, governing board and finances. Many Unichurch members serve at Kids Church on Sunday mornings - which is a great blessing for everyone. We gather in these ways:

- Morning church at 9.30am on Sundays at Ironside State School is our "family" gathering, with people of all ages and stages of life, and from many countries of the world. Programs for children and youth run during church.
- * **Unichurch** meets at University of Queensland, 4.30pm Sunday afternoons. In addition to those at university, we encourage students from year 10 to join, and graduates to continue serving with us there.
- * **Youth Group** for high schoolers runs on Friday nights at Ironside State School, 6.30 8.30pm.
- * Growth groups and Co-worker teams meet weekly at various times and places.

OUR NETWORKS AND PARTNERS

SLBC is a member of FIEC (Fellowship of Independent Evangelical Churches), a network of churches across Australia. We also support:

- * The university ministry of AFES (Australian Fellowship of Evangelical Students), at UQ, QUT and Griffith University.
- * City Bible Forum (CBF), encouraging and equipping Christians in the workplace, as they share the Gospel.
- * Some of our members have left us to work with CMS (Church Missionary Society), taking the Gospel of Jesus overseas.



Jesus taught his disciples that true greatness is to be found in humble service to others (Mark 10:45). So at SLBC we make it our goal not just to be served but to serve. We work hard to train and equip each other to be as useful as possible in serving the Kingdom.

- * **Connecting with peers.** We intentionally encourage young people to form real friendships with each other in the context of studying the bible and having fun and sharing life together. We want young people to have Christian friends as they grow together.

The Good News Course is a relaxed opportunity to find out about who Jesus is, why he came to earth and what it means to follow him.



GROWING STRONG IN FAITH

Growth Groups (GGs) at SLBC are more than just for making friends and supporting one another through life's ups and downs. As the name suggests, they are about **growing** - growing strong in the Christian faith. There are 3 main elements in our group time:

Bible: As we hear from God in the Bible, we grow in our knowledge of God and His plans and purposes for us and for this world. We also learn what it means to love God, to trust Him and follow Him in our daily lives. So that's why our GGs are centred on reading, understanding and believing the Bible.

Prayer: We know that only God has the power to grow us, so praying for one another, our church and the world, in response to what we learn from the Bible, is an essential part of our GGs.

Community: Also crucial for growing more and more like Jesus are loving, honest relationships with other Christians. Other believers help us understand the Bible better, gently help us see our blind spots, and encourage us when we doubt. To this end, our GGs happen in small weekly groups, usually in homes.

At SLBC there are different GGs to suit a diverse range of needs and preferences. We have groups: for those who are new to Christian things or are still exploring; for those with pre school children; for those for whom English is not their first language; for men; for women; as well as mixed groups.

CO-WORKER TEAMS

The Apostle Paul was not a lone ranger, but a member of a team of co-workers - a multi-national, inter-generational team devoted to proclaiming the gospel. As wonderful as all of this is, we discover the most astonishing thing about this team in 1 Corinthians 3:9. God is on the team. Paul describes himself as God's co-worker.

This is what our Co-Workers Teams are about: training up people who will not only work with us but with God himself to build his church. We want to train up mature and equipped disciples to serve within our own congregation, as evangelists, growth group leaders, welcomers, meeting leaders, musicians, board members, youth and kids leaders and more! And we want to train up people who will take initiative in ministry even when they are not given a specific job title.

But we also want to send out disciple making disciples (Matt. 28:18-20), to reach the world beyond us (2 Tim. 2:2). We want to make sure our leaders have gospel convictions, godly character, and suitable competencies to fulfil their responsibilities.

Our CWTs will spend most of their time helping our leaders to understand the gospel, to read their bibles and pray, to put sin to death in their lives and devote themselves to love and good works, to preach the gospel, to be servants and not tyrants.

The curriculum is based around 7 key areas:



Our usual practice is to invite people into a Co-Workers Team, but if you're interested in this training, get in touch with one of the staff.

MTS



MTS stands for the Ministry Training Strategy. At SLBC we are committed to training up lots and lots of gospel workers to send out into the Lord's abundant harvest field.

To that end we recruit godly, mission-minded apprentices, place them under the guiding hand of an experienced trainer, and give them a two-year full-immersion experience of working for a church.

We have two great Ministry Trainees with us in 2024; Nathan and Ashling Davis, and look forward to having more join us in the years to come.

WHATWE BELIEVE...



.... ABOUT THE BIBLE

* The divine inspiration and trustworthiness of the Holy Scripture as originally given, and their supreme authority in all matters of faith and conduct.

.... ABOUT GOD

- * The unity of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit in the Godhead.
- * The sovereign work of God in creation, revelation, redemption, judgment and establishing His kingdom.

.... ABOUT HUMANITY

- * The creation of men and women together in the image of God and together having dominion over the created order.
- * The universal sinfulness and guilt of human nature since the fall, rendering all people subject to God's wrath and condemnation, and unable to turn themselves to God without the prior regenerating work of God's Spirit, who convicts the world of sin, righteousness and judgment.

.... ABOUT JESUS CHRIST AND SALVATION

- * The conception of Jesus Christ by the Holy Spirit, and his birth by the virgin Mary. He is both God and sinless man.
- * Redemption from the guilt, penalty and power of sin, only through the sacrificial death, as our representative and substitute, of Jesus Christ, the incarnate Son of God, demonstrating God's love to us most perfectly and his victory over Satan and his forces.
- * The physical resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead in flesh, bones and body.
- * The necessity of the work of the Holy Spirit to make the death of Christ effective in individual sinners, granting them repentance towards God and faith in Jesus Christ, so that salvation is entirely by God's grace and not of their merit or good works.
- * The expectation of the personal return of the Lord Jesus Christ in glory to judge the living and the dead. The unity of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit in the Godhead.
